<u>O R D E R</u>

WHEREAS, as per the provision of section 12C (1) of Homoeopathy Central Council Act 1973 all Homoeopathy Medical Colleges shall seek permission of the Central Government within 01 year from the date of promulgation of HCC (Amendment) Ordinance, 2018.

2. WHEREAS, as per the policy of Ministry of Ayush, CCH examined the Part-1 of the proforma of inspection of college submitted by the **Sendhwa Homeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Sevanti Nagar, Niwali Road, Sendhwa, Madhya Pradesh** and recommended for not allowing admission in I-BHMS Course for the session 2020-21 due to substantial shortage in teaching faculties, hospital staffs and other shortfalls.

The reasons for recommendation for not granting permission to the Applicant College and Hospital are as under:-

"Recommended for not allowing admission in existing UG Course for the session 2020-21 due to substantial shortage in teaching faculties, hospital staffs, equipment and other deficiencies."

The reasons for recommendation for not granting permission to the Applicant College and Hospital are as under:-

1. Details of Teaching staff, Hospital staff, Hospital facilities & IPD/OPD details not updated in college website www.shmcsendhwa.com and college has not complied with the provisions of Employee's Provident Funds & Miscellaneous Provident Act 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.

2. As per enclosed affidavits, only 21FT teachers available against the requirement of 28. College had submitted a list of 31 teachers, out of which 10 teachers considered ineligible. Details of ineligible teachers are as under:

a. Dr Nilima Pawar (Lect, Physio)-not eligible as age exceeding 35 years at the time of joining as Lecturer, no previous exp. (DOB 11-05-73 appointment dated-1-3-09).

b. Dr Sanjeev K Joshi (Lecturer, Organon) not eligible as age exceeding 35 years at the time of joining as Lecturer, no previous exp. (DOB 30-8-61 appointment dated-1-6-02)

c. Dr BalasaheB S Kadam (Lecturer, Surgery) not eligible as age exceeding 35 years at the time of joining as Lecturer, no previous experience. (DOB 01-06-65, appointment dated-01-06-02).

d. Dr Dilip B. Kadam (Prof. OBG)- not eligible as age exceeding 35 years at the time of joining as Lecturer, no previous exp. (DOB 2-3-63 Appo dated-1-1-05)

e. Dr Narendra S Gawande (Lecturer, OBG)- not eligible as age exceeding 35 years at the time of joining as Lecturer, no previous experience (DOB 6-6-63, appointment date 01.06.2001)

f. Dr Manoj R. Chavan (Prof, CMD)- not eligible as age exceeding 35 years at the time of joining as Lecturer, no previous exp. (DOB 30-4-67, appointment dated- 01-01-05)

g. Dr Mahesh K Desale (Prof, Repertory)- not eligible as age exceeding 35 years at the time of joining as Lecturer, no previous exp. (DOB 15-1-68, appointment dated-01-01-05)

h. Affidavit of Lecturer (POM), Reader (Pharmacy) and not submitted.

i. Neither any affidavit nor any teacher's detail provided for Lecturer of Practice of Medicine, Reader of Pharmacy & Professor of Organon.

3. Not a single eligible teacher available in the Department of OBG.

4. Only 10 Guest Faculty available against the requirement of 12. However, no documents provided for the same for verification.

5. Only one Part Time teachers of Modern Medicine available against 09

6. Required number of Nursing Staff not available and Surgeon (General Surgery) is on call available against fulltime requirement in Hospital.

7. Required number of pH meter & Stop watch not available in the Teaching Departments of Pharmacy.

3. WHEREAS, the Central Government while examining the inspection report and recommendation of Board of Governors of CCH in terms of the provisions of HCC Act 1973 and the regulations made thereunder, has observed that the college is not fulfilling the following basic eligibility conditions: -

- Details of Teaching staff, Hospital staff, Hospital facilities & IPD/OPD details not updated in college website www.shmcsendhwa.com and college has not complied with the provisions of Employee's Provident Funds & Miscellaneous Provident Act 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
- As per enclosed affidavits, only 21 FT teachers available against the requirement of 28. College had submitted a list of 31 teachers, out of which 10 teachers considered ineligible. Details of ineligible teachers are as under:
 - a. Dr Nilima Pawar (Lect, Physio)-not eligible as age exceeding 35 years at the time of joining as Lecturer, NO previous exp. (DOB 11-05-73 appointment dated-1-3-09).
 - b. Dr Sanjeev K Joshi (Lecturer, Organon) not eligible as age exceeding 35 years at the time of joining as Lecturer, NO previous exp. (DOB 30-8-61 appointment dated-1-6-02)

- c. Dr BalasaheB S Kadam (Lecturer, Surgery) not eligible as age exceeding 35 years at the time of joining as Lecturer, NO previous experience. (DOB 01-06-65, appointment dated-01-06-02).
- d. Dr Dilip B. Kadam (Prof. OBG)- not eligible as age exceeding 35 years at the time of joining as Lecturer, NO previous exp. (DOB 2-3-63 Appointment dated-1-1-05)
- e. Dr Narendra S Gawande (Lecturer, OBG)- not eligible as age exceeding 35 years at the time of joining as Lecturer, NO previous experience (DOB 6-6-63, appointment date 01.06.2001)
- f. Dr Manoj R. Chavan (Prof, CMD)- not eligible as age exceeding 35 years at the time of joining as Lecturer, NO previous exp. (DOB 30-4-67, appointment dated- 01-01-05)
- g. Dr Mahesh K Desale (Prof, Repertory)- not eligible as age exceeding 35 years at the time of joining as Lecturer, NO previous exp. (DOB 15-1-68, appointment dated-01-01-05)
- h. Affidavit of Lecturer (POM), Reader (Pharmacy) and not submitted.
- i. Neither any affidavit nor any teacher's detail provided for Lecturer of Practice of Medicine, Reader of Pharmacy & Professor of Organon.
- 3. Not a single eligible teacher available in the Department of OBG.

4. Only 10 Guest Faculty available against the requirement of 12. However, no documents provided for the same for verification.

5. Only one Part Time teachers of Modern Medicine available against 09

6. Required number of Nursing Staff not available and Surgeon (General Surgery) is on call available against fulltime requirement in Hospital.

7. Required number of pH meter & Stop watch not available in the Teaching Departments of Pharmacy.

4. Whereas, in view of the deficiencies observed therein as mentioned in Para 3 above, the college was given an opportunity of hearing through Video-conferencing as a principle of natural justice of being heard vide Ministry's Hearing Notice of even no. dated 27.10.2020 to appear before the designated Hearing Committee in the Ministry of AYUSH to present their case for substantiating with respect to above mentioned short comings. The hearing was conducted on 11.11.2020 via video conferencing. The representative of the college submitted written submissions before the Hearing Committee.

5. The observation made by Hearing Committee is as under -

1) Details of Hospital staff, Teaching staff, Hospital facilities & IPD/OPD details not updated in college website www.shmcsendhawa.com.

The college representatives submitted that the details of Teaching Staff, Hospital Staff, Hospital Facility & IPD/OPD details are regularly updated on College Website www.shmcsendhwa.com.

The hearing committee examined the website and observed that details of Teaching Staff and Hospital Staff are available in the website. However details of hospital facility and OPD/IPD details are not available in the website.

Remarks of Ministry: As observed by Hearing committee details of Teaching Staff and Hospital Staff are available in the website. However details of hospital facility and OPD/IPD details are NOT available in the website.

2) College has not complied with the provisions of Employee's Provident Funds & Miscellaneous Provident Act 1952 & ESI Act 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.

The college representatives submitted that Employee Provident Fund is regularly deducted by the college. ECR and payment confirmation receipt w,r,t July 2020, August 2020 and September 2020 are submitted. They have further submitted that ESI Hospital Facility is not available in Sendhwa and ESI Hospital is located at Indore which is about 170 K.M. away from Sendhwa. As per the documents submitted, EPF is deducted from salaries of 18 employees of the college.

Remarks of Ministry: As observed by Hearing Committee College has NOT complied with the provisions of Employee's Provident Funds & Miscellaneous Provident Act 1952 & ESI Act 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.

3) As per enclosed affidavits, only 21 FT teachers are available against the requirement of 28. College has submitted a list of 31 teachers, out of which 10 teachers are considered ineligible. Details of ineligible teachers are as under.

a. Dr. Nilima Pawar (Lect, Physio) – not eligible as age exceeding 35 years at the time of joining as Lecturer, no previous exp. (DOB 11-05-73 appointment dated 1.03.09)

The college representatives submitted that Dr. Nilima Pawar (Lecturer Physiology) is having BHMS and M.Sc. Chemistry with the subject Bio-Chemistry and hence she is eligible for 5 year relaxation of age. They have further submitted that she has been approved under University College Code-28 of Devi Ahilya University, Indore. Upon examination of the documents it is observed that Dr. Nilima Pawar is having BSc Chemistry, BHMS and MSc Physical Chemistry qualifications. However she does not possess essential qualification as per MSR i.e, either Post Graduation in Homeopathy or Post Graduation in concerned subject. No documents regarding experience in concerned subject are submitted.

Remarks of Ministry: As observed by Hearing Committee Dr. Nilima Pawar (Lecturer Physiology) as age exceeding 35 years at the time of joining as Lecturer and she does NOT possess essential qualification as per MSR. No documents regarding her educational qualification, previous experience of Demonstrator in concerned subject are submitted. Hence, Dr. Nilima Pawar Lecturer, Physiology is not eligible.

b. Dr. Sanjeev K Joshi (Lecturer, Organon) not eligible as age exceeding 35 years at the time of joining as Lecturer, no previous exp. DOB 30-08-61 appointment dated 01.06.02)

The college representatives submitted that the college has appointed Dr. Pavansingh Nayakal Patil (MD Hom.) as Lecturer Organon of Medicine, on 06.11.2020. However the college has NOT submitted any supporting documents regarding this claim.

Remarks of Ministry: As observed by Hearing Committee College has appointed Dr. Pavansingh Nayakal Patil (MD Hom.) as Lecturer Organon of Medicine, on 06.11.2020. However the college has NOT submitted any supporting documents regarding this claim. Hence, both faculties are considered ineligible.

c. Dr. Balasaheb B S Kadam (Lecturer, Surgery) not eligible as age exceeding 35 years at the time of joining as Lecturer, no previous experience. (DOB 01-06-65, appointment dated 01.06.02.

The college representatives have not submitted any previous experience certificate before joining as lecturer on 01.01.2017 in the present college.

Remarks of Ministry: As observed by Hearing Committee the college representatives have NOT submitted any previous experience certificate of Dr. Balasaheb B S Kadam. Hence, Dr. Balasaheb B S Kadam (Lecturer, Surgery) is not eligible.

d. Dr. Dilip B Kadam (Prof OBG) – not eligible as age exceeding 35 years at the time of joining as lecturer, no previous exp. (DOB 2.03.63 appointment dated 01.01.05).

The college has submitted appointment letter, joining report dated 01.01.05, DHMS passing certificate, promotion order to the post of Reader dated 01.01.2009, promotion order to the post of Professor dated 01.01.13 and previous experience certificate.

Upon examination of these documents, it is observed that the date of issuing of previous experience certificate is not clear from the submitted document. The document mentions about his experience as Lecturer Gynecology- Obstetrics from 01.06.1996 to 31.12.2004 at Homeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Shirpur Dist., Dhule. However the language of the certificate appears to be odd. Further PG certificate is NOT submitted by the college.

Remarks of Ministry: As per the affidavit submitted by college, Dr. Dilip B Kadam (Prof OBG) is not eligible as age exceeding 35 years at the time of joining as lecturer in 1.01.2005. Further PG certificate is NOT submitted by the college. Hence Dr. Dilip B Kadam is not eligible.

e. Dr. Narendra S Gawande (Lecturer OBG)- not eligible as age exceeding 35 years at the time of joining as Lecturer, no previous exp (DOB- 06.06.63, appointment date 01.06.2001.

The college representatives have submitted that Dr. Jitendra Lunkad MD (Hom.) is newly appointed as Lecturer OBG on 07.11.2020. They have submitted 10th certificate, appointment order, joining letter, degree certificate, MD certificate and registration.

Upon examination of the documents it is observed that Date of birth of Dr. Jitendra Lunkad is 05.11.1981. Post-Graduation is in Practice of Medicine. NO experience regarding Obstetrics and Gynaecology are submitted.

Remarks of Ministry: As observed by Hearing Committee College has appointed Dr. Jitendra Lunkad (MD Hom.) as Lecturer OBG on 07.11.2020.

f. Dr. Manoj R Chavan (Professor, CMD) - not eligible as age exceeding 35 years at the time of joining as Lecturer, no previous exp (DOB 30-04-67, appointment date 01-01-05).

The college representatives submitted that Dr. Ramashish Yadav (MD Hom.) joined the college as Professor Community Medicine on 04.08. 2020. However they have not submitted any supporting documents for substantiating this claim.

Remarks of Ministry: As observed by Hearing Committee College has appointed Dr. Ramashish Yadav (MD Hom.) Professor Community Medicine on 04.08.2020 but they have not submitted any supporting documents for substantiating this claim. Hence, both faculties are considered ineligible. Hence there is NO eligible higher faculty in CMD.

g. Dr. Mahesh K Desale (Prof. Repertory) - not eligible as age exceeding 35 years at the time of joining as Lecturer, no previous exp (DOB 15-01-68, appointment date 01.01.05)

The college representatives submitted that the date of initial appointment of Dr. Mahesh K. Desale as Lecturer is 28.11.1999 and he was within the age limit at that time. They have submitted experience certificate from Homeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Shirpur, Dhule. As per the experience certificate from Homeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Shirpur, Dhule Dr. Mahesh K. Desale worked as Lecturer, Repertory from 28.12.1999 to 31.12.2004. His age at the time of appointment is 31 years. But he has no previous 4 years demonstrator experience. Hence, Dr. Mahesh K. Desale is not eligible.

Remarks of Ministry: As observed by Hearing committee Dr. Mahesh K. Desale worked as Lecturer, Repertory from 28.12.1999 to 31.12.2004. His age at the time of appointment as per this is 31 years. But he has no previous 4 years demonstrator experience. Hence, Dr. Mahesh K. Desale is not eligible.

h. Affidavit of Lecturer (POM), Reader (Pharmacy) not submitted.

The college representatives have submitted Affidavits of Dr. Nikhil Parab (Lecturer Practice of Medicine) and Dr. Sushil Bagul (Reader Pharmacy). Upon examination of these affidavits it is observed that specialization of MD is not mentioned in the affidavit of Dr. Nikhil Parab. Dr. Sushil Bagul (Reader Pharmacy) does not possess post graduate degree. He is having DHMS qualification from Maharashtra Council of Homeopathy in the year 1999.

Remarks of Ministry: As observed by Hearing committee Specialization subject of MD is not mentioned in the affidavit of Dr. Nikhil Parab (Lecturer (POM)). Dr. Sushil Bagul (Reader Pharmacy) completed DHMS in 1999 and joined as Assistant professor in 01.06.2002 without any previous 4 years' experience of Demonstrator. Hence, Dr. Sushil Bagul (Reader Pharmacy) is not eligible. Incomplete Affidavit of Lecturer (POM), Reader (Pharmacy) are submitted. Hence Lecturer (POM), Reader (Pharmacy) are NOT eligible.

i. Neither any affidavit nor any teacher's detail provided for Lecturer of Practice of Medicine, Reader of Pharmacy & Professor of Organon.

The college representatives submitted that Affidavits and details of Lecturer of Practice of Medicine (Dr. Nikhil Parab) and Reader Pharmacy (Dr. Sushil Bagul) have already submitted to CCH on 20.07.2020. They have submitted Affidavits of these two faculties for verification by hearing committee. Upon examination of these affidavits it is observed that specialization of MD is not mentioned in the affidavit of Dr.Nikhil Parab. Dr. Sushil Bagul (Reader Pharmacy) does not possess post graduate degree. He is having DHMS qualification from Maharashtra Council of Homeopathy in the year 1999.

Regarding Professor of Organon of Medicine, the college representatives submitted that Dr. Rajesh Mahale has resigned from the Institute and relieved on 31.07.2020 and Dr. Hemant Khairnar (Associate Professor) is promoted to the post of Professor on 31.07.2020. They have further submitted that Dr. Sonali Thakare (Associate Professor- Guest Faculty) is appointed to the post of Associate Professor- Fulltime on 31.07.2020. They have submitted relieving letter of Dr. Rajesh Mahale, promotion letter of Dr. Hemant Khairnar and appointment letter of Dr. Sonali Thakare.

Affidavits or any other documents like attendance register, salary statement and educational qualification details with respect to Professor of Organon are not submitted.

Remarks of Ministry: As observed by Hearing committee in affidavits specialization of MD is not mentioned in the affidavit of Dr. Nikhil Parab. Other documents like educational qualification, registration certificate, attendance register, salary details of Dr. Nikhil Parab not provided by the college.

Dr. Sushil Bagul (Reader Pharmacy) does not possess post graduate degree. He is having DHMS qualification from Maharashtra Council of Homeopathy in the year 1999. His date of Birth is 27.12.1976. He joined this college on the post of Lecturer on 01.06.2002 without previous 4 years' experience of Demonstrator. Hence, Dr. Sushil Bagul (Reader Pharmacy) is NOT eligible.

Affidavits or any other documents like attendance register, salary statement and educational qualification details with respect to Professor of Organon are not submitted.

4) Not a single eligible teacher available in the Department of OBG.

The college representatives submitted that the following eligible teachers are available in the Dept. of OBG.

• Dr. Dilip Kadam (Professor OBG) - The college has submitted appointment letter, joining report dated 01.01.05, DHMS passing certificate, promotion order to the post of Reader dated 01.01.2009, promotion order to the post of Professor dated 01.01.13 and previous experience certificate.

Upon examination of these documents, it is observed that the date of issuing of previous experience certificate is not clear from the submitted document. The document mentions about his experience as Lecturer Gynecology - Obstetrics from 01.06.1996 to 31.12.2004 at Homeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Shirpur Dist., Dhule. However the language of the certificate appears to be odd. Further PG certificate is not submitted by the college.

• Dr. Jitendra Lunkad (MD Hom.) – The college has submitted that he has been appointed as Lecturer in the Dept. of OBG on 06.11.2020. Supporting documents like proof of date of birth, appointment letter, joining report dated 07.11.2020, educational qualification details such MD certificate, registration certificate are submitted by the college.

Upon examination of these documents it is observed that as per the 10th certificate, his DOB is 05.11.1981 and hence the age is 39 years at the date of joining. Details of previous experience are not submitted. His MD is in Practice of Medicine.

5) Only 10 Guest faculties available against the requirement of 12. However no documents provided for the same for verification.

The college representatives submitted that 11 Guest Faculty are available in the college. The college representatives submitted a list of 11 Guest Faculty.

- i. Dr. S Prasad As per his pan card, date of birth is 02.06.1946. Age is 73 years.
- ii. Dr. S.N. Singh Professor in Repertory, appointment on 28.09. 2012. Date of Birth is 18.07.46. Age 73 years.
- iii. Dr. Subhash Kale- Professor, Guest faculty in the Dept. of Materia Medica as per appointment order dated 30.12.2010, Joining report, DHMS passing certificate and registration certificate are submitted.
- iv. Dr. Sushil bagul As per appointment order dated 01.06.2002, appointed as Lecturer in Dept. of Pharmacy. DHMS certificate, promotion order dated 01.06.2009 are submitted.
- v. Dr. Pradeep Purohit Appointment letter, joining report and promotion letter are submitted. No documents for proving educational qualification are submitted.
- vi. Dr. Bhalchandra Thakare As per appointment order dated 30. 05.2011, appointed as Reader (Guest faculty) in the Dept. of FMT. Joining report, experience certificate and registration certificates are submitted.
- vii.Dr Syam Patil As per appointment order dated 29.05.2002, appointed as Lecturer in Dept. of Physiology. Joining letter, promotion order, DHMS passing certificate, registration certificate are submitted.
- viii.Dr Prakash Amale As per the appointment order dated 25.10.2004, appointed as Lecturer in the Dept. of Anatomy. Joining letter, DHMS passing certificate, registration certificate, promotion order to the post of Reader Anatomy are submitted.
- ix. Dr. Vinay Moghal- As per the appointment order dated 26.07.2017 appointed as Associate professor in the Dept of OBG & Homeopathic therapeutics. Joining report, DHMS certificate, registration certificate are submitted. Experience certificate not submitted.
- x. Dr. Shashikant Joshi- As per appointment order dated 30.06.2017, Associate Professor, Full Time in the Department of Surgery. Joining letter, DHMS passing certificate and Registration certificate are submitted.
- xi. Dr. Piyush Joshi As per the documents, name is Piyush Jhavar. As per appointment letter 01. 05.2018, Lecturer in the Dept. of Practice of Medicine. Joining letter, MBBS Degree certificate, Registration Certificate are submitted.

Biometric attendance statement w.r.t only October 2020 is submitted. Salary details of above said faculties are not submitted.

Remarks of Ministry: As observed by Hearing committee 10 Guest faculties available against the requirement of 12. However no documents provided for verification of the same.

6) Only one Part time teachers of Modern Medicine available against 09.

The college has submitted that it is not mandatory to have all Guest Faculty Teachers from modern medicine. They have admitted that only one part time teacher of modern medicine is available and others are guest faculties mentioned at Point no. 5 above.

Remarks of Ministry: As observed by Hearing committee that only one Part time teacher of Modern Medicine available.

7) Average bed occupancy has found 2.2% against requirement 30%.

The college representatives have submitted that average bed occupancy of a single day was uploaded while filling up Part-1 format by mistake and the same was communicated to CCIM vide email dated 16.09.2020. They have further submitted that the actual bed occupancy is 62.44% as per the following calculation:

5698 (Total No. of Patents) x 100 = 62.44%

365 x 25 (Total No. of Existing Beds)

They have submitted statement regarding date wise and month wise bed occupancy.

Remarks of Ministry: As observed by Hearing committee average bed occupancy is 62.44%.

8) Required number of nursing staff not available and Surgeon (General Surgery) is on call available against full time requirement in Hospital.

The college representatives submitted that 01 Nursing Staff In-Charge (Kiran Billade) and 03 Nursing Staff (Miss Krishna Kharte, Miss Nirmala Badole and Miss Subhadra Badole) are available in the college. However while uploading data in Part I only 02 Nursing Staff were mentioned by mistake. They have submitted registration certificates and duty roster of these staff.

Upon examination of these documents, it is observed that Kiran Billade and Krishna Kharte are having Auxillary Nurse Midwife Certificate while Nirmala Badole and Subhadra Badole are having Certificate in Mahila Ayurved Swastya Karyakarta from Sri Sai Paramedical Institute, Barwani, MP. No other documents like appointment letter, joining order, salary details are submitted.

The college representatives have submitted that Dr. Sunil Wadile, has been appointed as Full time Surgeon and he has joined the institute on 07.11.2020. They have submitted qualification details of Dr Sunil Wadile. However documents like appointment letter, joining letter and attendance details are not submitted.

Remarks of Ministry: As observed by Hearing committee required number of nursing staff not available. Dr. Sunil Wadile, has been appointed as Full time Surgeon and he has joined the institute on 07.11.2020. Educational qualification is submitted and no other documents like appointment letter, joining letter and attendance details are submitted. Hence, Full time Surgeon is not available.

9) Required number of pH meter and Stop watch not available in the Teaching Departments of Pharmacy.

The college representatives submitted that 02 pH meter and 25 stopwatches are available in the college since 2014. However while filling up format of Part-1, number of PH Meters and stopwatch were mentioned as 01 due to technical error. They have submitted invoice dated 22.01.14, Central Stock Register & Departmental Stock Register.

As per the invoice and stock register, 02 pH meter and 25 stop watches are available in the Teaching Department of Pharmacy.

Remarks of Ministry: As observed by Hearing committee that 02 pH meter and 25 stop

watches are available in the Teaching Department of Pharmacy.

Overall observations:

- Details of Teaching Staff and Hospital Staff are available in the website www.shmcsendhwa.com. However details of hospital facility and OPD/IPD details are not available in the website.
- College has not complied with the provisions of ESI Act 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
- Dr. Nilima Pawar (Lecturer Physiology) does not possess essential qualification as per MSR i.e, either Post Graduation in Homeopathy or Post Graduation in concerned subject. No documents regarding experience in concerned subject are submitted.
- The college representatives have not submitted any previous experience certificate of Dr. Balasaheb B S Kadam (Lecturer, Surgery).
- Supporting documents for substantiating appointment of Dr. Ramashish Yadav (MD Hom.) as Professor Community Medicine on 04.08. 2020 are not submitted.
- As per the experience certificate from Homeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Shirpur, Dhule Dr. Mahesh K. Desale worked as Lecturer, Repertory from 28.12.1999 to 31.12.2004. His age at the time of appointment as per this is 31 years. But he has no previous 4 years demonstrator experience. Hence, Dr. Mahesh K. Desale is not eligible.
- Specialization subject of MD is not mentioned in the affidavit of Dr.Nikhil Parab (Lecturer (POM)). Dr. Sushil Bagul (Reader Pharmacy) does not possess post graduate degree.
- Regarding Guest faculties, Biometric attendance statement of October 2020 only are submitted. Salary details are not submitted.
- Only one part time teacher of modern medicine is available.
- Documents like appointment letter, joining order, salary details of Nursing staff and Surgeon are not submitted.
- As per the invoice and stock register, 02 pH meter and 25 stop watches are available in the Teaching Department of Pharmacy.

6. Whereas, in view of the above observations of the Hearing Committee based on submission made by the college during hearing as in Para 5 above and the recommendations of the CCH referred in Para 2 above, it can be understood that as per the norms, the college does not fulfill the eligibility conditions for granting permission for taking admission in BHMS course with 100 seats for the academic year 2020-21 as college is not having requisite full time teaching faculties and other deficiencies at the time of submission of Part-1 of Proforma of inspection of college.

7. Now, therefore, in view of the shortcomings and deficiencies mentioned pointed out by CCH and observations of hearing committee above, which violate the provisions of the HCC Act and the relevant regulations and are of such a serious and fundamental in nature that they adversely affect the ability of the College to provide quality medical education in terms of the provisions of the HCC Act and the relevant regulations **Sendhwa Homeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Sevanti Nagar, Niwali Road, Sendhwa, Madhya Pradesh**, **is hereby denied permission for taking admission in 1-BHMS course with intake capacity of 100 UG seats for the academic session 2020-21.**

8. The College shall comply with the provision for providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, Non-teaching staff of the College/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provident Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations which will be verified while considering the matter for grant of permission for the A.Y. 2021-22.

9. Further, the College shall submit comply with the procedure to get permanent registration of the Teachers,/ Hospital Clinical Staff/ Consultant in concerned State Boards/ Council where the college/ hospital is located or Central Registration of CCH by 31st per the decision 2020 conveyed vide CCH's letter December, as no. 15-1/2018-CCH(3)/18510-18768, dated 16th January, 2019 and decided by the High Court of Delhi in W.P. No. 2369 of 2019, which will be verified by the Council during next visitation while considering the matter for grant of permission for the A.Y. 2021-22.

10. Further, it is informed that the college is being provided a period up to 31.12.2020 to fulfill the shortcomings observed during this year as mentioned at Para 5 above along with the following requirements, so that the CCH may carry out inspection of the college for consideration of matter for grant of permission for taking admissions in BHMS course from the academic year 2021-22:

- a. all the Minimum Standard Requirements of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Homoeopathy Central Council (Minimum Standard Requirements of Homoeopathic Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2013" by 31st December 2020. And
- b. all the requirements under the provisions of the HCC Act, 1973 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*.
- 11. This issues with the approval of the Competent Authority.
