Sir,

The Medical Assessment and Rating Board has received online application (Part-1) seeking permission for student intake in Under Graduate (BHMS) course with student intake of 100 seats for the academic year 2022-23.

2. As per provision of NCH Act, 2020 Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy (MA&RBH) has been constituted with the mandate to grant permission for student intake to the existing and new medical institution of Homoeopathy. Accordingly, it is to inform that Part-1 Performa and all the relevant documents submitted by your college were examined as per the existing regulations. On scrutiny and careful consideration of your documents and further observations of the Board, the following shortfalls to be addressed for granting permission for student intake in UG (BHMS) course for the academic year 2022-23:

A. Teaching Faculty:

- College may justify the engagement of Dr. Deepak Mitthulal Jain (Reader, Physiology) and Dr. Hemant Damodar Dalvi (Professor, Practice of Medicine) in accordance to the relevant regulations.
- Acquittance and Form-16 of 03 full time teachers not provided.

B. Hospital Staff: Attendance and Acquittance of 08 hospital staff not provided.

C. Miscellaneous:

- Salary bank statement not provided.
- Website functional but teaching faculty details and Student's data of 2021-22 not provided as checked on 16.09.2022. College need to provide list of Student's admitted through NEET in the website which is not available.

4. That the applicant has set up the Homoeopathic Medical College and teaching Hospital with the component of staff, infrastructure, equipment and instruments and other facilities where as the College has to take urgent and time bound steps to fulfill the above requirements for conducting Under Graduate course in Homoeopathy.


5. After considering the provisions of NCH Act, 2020 the permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for continuing admission is granted to Sendhwa Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Sevanti Nagar Niwali Road, Madhya Pradesh, Sendhwa-451666 with student intake of 100 seats for the academic year 2022-23.

6. All admissions in Under Graduate (BHMS) course shall be through 'National Eligibility Entrance Test (NEET) only. It is further informed that, minimum 15% seats of permitted intake capacity of BHMS course shall be treated as All India Quota. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy as per rules, and the penalty as decided by NCH will be imposed.

7. The counseling for seats under All India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling Authority of State/ UT Government as designated by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State / UT. 100% Under Graduate & Post Graduate seats of the permitted intake capacity shall be treated as all India quota for Deemed University as they are All India in nature. The Counseling of seats under All India Quota shall be conducted by Central Government.


8. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India quota or the student admitted there under. The category wise list of students admitted may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed.
